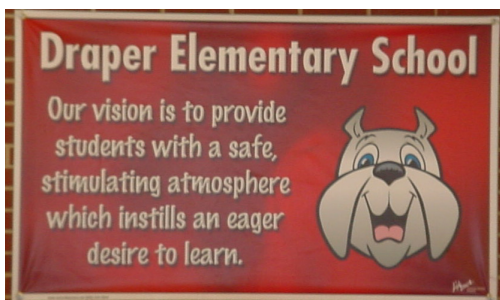


Draper's History

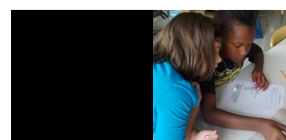
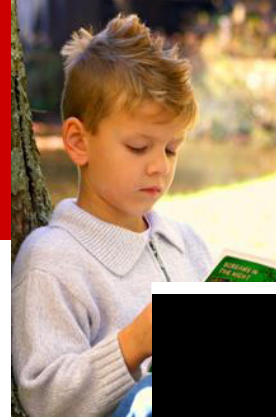
