By signing below, parent/guardian and student understand and agree to all of the following:

1. The household does not already have internet access.
2. Only one device will be issued to a household.
3. The device and power adapter will be returned to the school either at the end of the grant (2025-26), a date designated for return by the school system, student moves, student graduates, or if the device is no longer needed.
4. The replacement cost of the mobile hotspot and power adapter is **\$75.00** and is payable to the school.
5. Ensure the mobile hotspots and monthly internet service will only be used for educational purposes.
6. The mobile hotspot is CIPA compliant and provided by T-Mobile. T-mobile's content filter prevents access to inappropriate content. Altering the configuration of the equipment is prohibited.
7. Each hotspot can accommodate the connection of multiple student devices.
8. Unlimited high-speed data is included each month.
9. The student has read the Technology Acceptable Use Policy located at <https://www.rock.k12.nc.us/parents-and-students>.

The District prohibits unethical use of the Internet, email, and other media. Violation of this policy may result in the loss of equipment and privileges, and disciplinary action by the school/district.
