



If you have trouble enrolling your student, then the following steps should be taken:

1. Complete Dispute Resolution Process Form (DRP 1). Keep a copy for your records.
2. Forward a copy of DRP 1 to the Central Office Homeless Liaison for dispute resolution. The student should attend and fully participate in the school of choice until the dispute is resolved. The parent/guardian/unaccompanied youth should provide any written or oral documentation to support their position to the school. The Rockingham County Schools Homeless Liaison may be contacted at:

3. The parent/guardian/unaccompanied youth will be notified of resolution in writing by the Homeless Liaison within 5 working days.
