Rockingham County Schools hires Sean Gladieux as new Director of Safety, Public Information Officer

At the Monday, March 27 Work Session of the Rockingham County Schools Board of Education, the district's leadership officially hired Sean Gladieux as the district's new Director of Safety and Public Information Officer. Mr. Gladieux will begin his official duties on April 17, 2023.

Mr. Gladieux comes to Rockingham County Schools with 25 years of law enforcement experience with the Greensboro Police Department, where he held numerous leadership positions in the department before retiring as Captain of the Training Division. He has attended numerous law enforcement and leadership schools, held a number of certifications, and has been an instructor and adjunct professor at Guilford Technical Community College.

After a successful law enforcement career, Sean transitioned to the private sector, becoming the Vice President of Operations at Technology Concepts & Design, Inc., a legal technology and services company headquartered in Greensboro, North Carolina. In addition to his Vice President duties and responsibilities, Mr. Gladieux was the subject matter expert of physical security, conducting security assessments of museums, hall of fames, banks, corporate offices and educational complexes.

Sean obtained his Bachelor of Arts in Communications and Political Science from Bowling Green State University and his Master of Science in Criminal Justice with a specialization in Security and Terrorism from East Carolina University. Mr. Gladieux and his wife Jill have lived in Greensboro for over 30 years and have one daughter, Gabrielle, who attends the University of Alabama and is a member of the Crimson Tide women's gymnastics team.
